

School of Life Sciences Bicycle Policy

1. Bicycles of SoLS faculty, staff, postdocs and graduate students may be taken into the Life Sciences building complex if, and only, if:
 - a. Bicycles are stored in such a way so that they do not use up potentially usable office or laboratory space
 - b. Bicycles are not stored in stairwells, hallways or corridors
 - c. Bicycles are not stored overnight
 - d. Bicycles do not impede emergency egress
2. Bicycles may be transported in elevators but the transportation of wheelchairs, carts, package delivery, etc. has priority. Bicycles must be removed from the elevator when impeding transportation of other items. During emergency evacuations, bicycles may not be taken out of the building via the elevators.
3. Bicycles may be parked on the landing outside the LSE building (west side of building), but all entrances to the building, to the stairwell, and to the elevators must be kept completely free. Bicycles in this area may be locked only to the railing, but not so as to obstruct any entrance, stairwell or elevator. Bicycles may not be left parked overnight.
4. Improperly parked bicycles will be removed and impounded.
